**The Authors represent that the work is author-owned unless one of the following options is checked:**

- Work made for hire for employer** – the Contribution was prepared by the Author within the scope of his/her employment and copyright in the Contribution is owned by the Author's employer. Both the Author and an authorized representative of the Author's employer must sign this Agreement. Please indicate "**Employer**": \_\_\_\_\_
- U.S. Government work** – the Author is an employee of the United States Government and prepared the Contribution as part of his/her official duties. If the Contribution was not prepared as part of the Author's official duties, it is not a U.S. Government work. If the Contribution was jointly authored, all the coauthors must have been United States Government employees at the time they prepared the Contribution in order for it to be a U.S. Government work; if any coauthor was not a United States Government employee, then the Contribution is not a U.S. Government work. If the Contribution was prepared under a U.S. Government contract or grant, it is not a U.S. Government work (in such case, copyright is usually owned by the contractor or grantee).

All the Authors of the Contribution (and Employer, if the Contribution is a work made for hire for Employer) are jointly and severally referred to as "**Contributor**."

**SAGE Publications, Inc.**, 2455 Teller Road, Thousand Oaks, CA 91320 ("**SAGE**"), owner and publisher of the Journal, is pleased to consider the previously unpublished original work described above (text plus other materials to be published as part of the work, such as but not limited to tables, figures, graphs, charts, drawings, photographs and other illustrations, digital media works, and the abstract) (the "**Contribution**") for publication in the Journal. To enable SAGE to disseminate the Contribution to the fullest extent possible, SAGE requires this Copyright Transfer Agreement be signed by the Contributor. If and when the Contribution is accepted for publication in the Journal, the following terms and conditions shall become effective as of the date of Contributor's execution of this Agreement:

**1. Transfer of Copyright.** Contributor transfers and assigns to SAGE for the full term of copyright and any extensions and renewals thereof, all right, title, and interest in copyright, and all of the rights comprised therein and all remedies afforded by law, throughout the world (for U.S. Government works, see paragraph 3 below) in and to the Contribution, exclusive of any copyrightable material (text or graphic) owned by others, and any revisions thereof prepared and submitted by Contributor, including without limitation the right to register copyright in the Contribution in SAGE's name and the exclusive right to reproduce, publish, republish, prepare all foreign language translations and other derivative works, distribute, sell, license, transfer, transmit, and publicly display copies of, and otherwise use the Contribution, in whole or in part, alone or in compilations, in all formats and media and by any method, device, or process, and through any channels, now known or later conceived or developed; and the exclusive right to license or otherwise authorize others to do all of the foregoing, and the right to assign and transfer the rights granted hereunder. To the extent that any right now or in the future existing under copyright is not specifically granted to SAGE by the terms of this Agreement, such right shall be deemed to have been granted hereunder.

**2. License to Contributor.** Subject to the terms and conditions of this paragraph, SAGE grants to Contributor a worldwide, nonexclusive, perpetual license to exercise the rights in the Contribution set forth below:

- (a) after initial publication in the print format of the Journal, to use and reproduce, in print format, all or part of the Contribution in any literary work written or edited by an Author;
- (b) to photocopy the published Contribution, in whole or in part, and distribute such copies to students free of charge for an Author's own classroom teaching use;

(c) no sooner than twelve (12) months after publication of the Contribution in the print format of the Journal, to post an electronic copy of a Contributor-created version of all or part of the Contribution and abstract as accepted for publication by the Journal (i.e., updated to include all changes made during the peer-review and editing process), on Contributor's own personal web site and on Contributor's employer's web site or repository, provided that such electronic copy includes a hyperlink to the published version of the Contribution on the SAGE Journals Online website together with the following text: "The final, definitive version is available at <http://online.sagepub.com/>." Contributor is not permitted to post the SAGE PDF version of the published Contribution on any web site or repository.

The licenses granted above in this paragraph 2 are expressly made subject to and limited by the following restrictions:

- In each instance of use of the Contribution, or any part of it, Contributor includes the copyright notice that appears on the issue of the Journal in which the Contribution is first published and a full bibliographic citation to the Journal as published by SAGE;
- Copies of the Contribution, or any part of it, are not sold, distributed, or reproduced for commercial purposes (i.e., for monetary gain on Contributor's own account or on that of a third party, or for indirect financial gain by a commercial entity);
- The Contribution, or any part of it, is not used for any systematic external distribution by a third party (e.g., a listserv or database connected to a public access server); and
- All third party requests to re-use the Contribution, in whole or in part, are forwarded to SAGE.

**3. U.S. Government Works.** If the Contribution is designated above as a U.S. Government work, Contributor hereby certifies that all the Authors were officers or employees of the United States Government at the time the Contribution was prepared and that it was prepared by the Authors as part of their official government duties. SAGE acknowledges that under the Copyright Act of 1976, as amended, United States copyright protection is not available for U.S. Government works, which are considered to be in the public domain in the United States. U.S. Government works may, however, be protected in other countries under foreign copyright laws governing ownership of foreign copyrights in U.S. Government works. Accordingly, if the Contribution is a U.S. Government work, paragraph 1 shall apply only outside the United States.

**4. Works Prepared Under U.S. Government Contract or Grant.** If the Contribution was prepared under a U.S. Government contract or grant, SAGE acknowledges that the United States Government reserves a royalty-free, nonexclusive and irrevocable right to reproduce, publish, or otherwise use the Contribution for official United States Government purposes only, and to authorize others to do so, if the U.S. Government contract or grant so requires. Upon request, Contributor will provide SAGE with the contract number of the U.S. Government contract or grant and/or a copy of the contract.

**5. Permissions.** If the Contribution contains copyrighted material (text or graphic) owned by others, then Contributor, at Contributor's expense, shall obtain written permission from the copyright owner, in form and scope acceptable to SAGE, to include and reproduce such copyrighted material in the Contribution and in the Journal. Contributor shall deliver all written permissions to SAGE together with delivery of the manuscript of the Contribution. Delivery of all required written permissions is a condition of publication of the Contribution in the Journal.

**6. Copyediting; Proofreading.** SAGE may copyedit the Contribution for clarity, brevity, accuracy, grammar, word usage, and conformity style and presentation as SAGE deems advisable for production and publication in the Journal. The Corresponding Author shall proofread proofs of the Contribution and indicate any proposed corrections or other changes and timely return them to SAGE as directed, time being of the essence. SAGE may charge to Contributor the cost of making *extensive* text changes in proofs requested by the Corresponding Author at a rate of \$2.00 per line. If corrected proofs are not timely returned, SAGE may proceed with the publication of the Contribution as it deems appropriate.

**7. Credit; Use of Name and Likeness.** Each Author will receive credit as an author of the Contribution when it is published in the Journal; the form and placement of the credit will be determined by SAGE. Each Author grants SAGE the right to use his/her name, likeness, biographical information, and professional credits on copies of the Contribution and the Journal and in connection with the exercise of any other of SAGE's rights granted hereunder and in advertising, marketing, and promotion in connection therewith, and to grant such rights to any licensees or assigns of SAGE's rights hereunder.

**8. Contributor Copies.** SAGE will provide to Contributor (or to the Corresponding Author on behalf of Contributor) one (1) print form copy of the issue of the Journal in which the Contribution is first published. Additional reprints of the Contribution may be purchased from SAGE at its regularly scheduled prices.

**9. Warranties; Indemnification.** Contributor warrants and represents that (a) Contributor has the full power and authority to enter into and execute this Agreement and to convey the rights granted herein, and that such rights are not now subject to prior assignment, transfer or other encumbrance; (b) the Contribution is the original work of the Author(s) (except for copyrighted material owned by others for which written permission has been obtained), has not been previously published in any form, and has been submitted only to the Journal; (c) the Contribution does not infringe the copyright or violate any proprietary rights, rights of privacy or publicity, or any other rights of any third party, and does not contain any material that is libelous or otherwise contrary to law; (d) all statements in the Contribution asserted as fact are either true or based upon generally accepted professional research

practices, and no formula or procedure contained therein would cause injury if used in accordance with the instructions and/or warnings included in the Contribution; and (e) any studies on which the Contribution is directly based were satisfactorily conducted in compliance with the governing Institutional Review Board (IRB) standards or exempt from IRB requirements. In the event that Contributor is in breach of any of the aforementioned warranties or representations, Contributor shall indemnify and hold harmless the Editor and SAGE, its affiliates, assigns and licensees, against any losses, liabilities, damages, costs and expenses (including legal costs and expenses) arising from or resulting out of any claim or demand of any kind relating to such breach.

**10. Termination.** This Agreement must be signed by each Author (and Employer, if the Contribution is a work made for hire for Employer) and delivered to SAGE as a condition of publication of the Contribution in the Journal. SAGE makes no guarantee that the Contribution will be published in the Journal. If, for any reason, the Contribution is not published in the Journal, then all rights in the Contribution transferred and assigned to SAGE hereunder shall revert to Contributor and this Agreement shall be of no further force and effect, and neither SAGE nor Contributor will have any obligation to the other with respect to the Contribution.

**11. Governing Law.** The validity, interpretation, performance and enforcement of this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of California without regard to the conflicts of laws principles thereof that would give rise to the application of the domestic substantive law of any other jurisdiction.

**12. Dispute Resolution.** In the event a dispute arises out of or relating to this Agreement, the parties agree to first make a good faith effort to resolve such dispute themselves. Upon failing, the parties shall engage in non-binding mediation with a mediator to be mutually agreed upon by the parties. Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement, or the breach thereof, which the parties can not settle themselves or through mediation shall be settled by arbitration in Los Angeles, California and administered by the American Arbitration Association in accordance with its then-existing Commercial Arbitration Rules. The award rendered by the arbitrator or arbitrators shall be final, and judgment may be entered upon it in accordance with applicable law in any court having jurisdiction thereof. Each party consents to, and waives any right to object to, jurisdiction with respect to the resolution of disputes hereunder in Los Angeles, California. In any legal action or other proceedings (including arbitration proceedings) between the parties, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover from the non-prevailing party all reasonable costs and expenses incurred in such action or proceeding, including without limitation reasonable attorneys' fees and costs.

**13. Counterparts; Facsimile.** This Agreement may be executed in counterparts, each of which shall be deemed the original, all of which together shall constitute one and the same instrument. A faxed copy shall be deemed as an original, but the parties agree to forward a hard-copy of their respective signatures to the other party promptly thereafter.

**14. Modification; Entire Agreement; Severability.** No amendment or modification of any provision of this Agreement shall be valid or binding unless made in writing and signed by all parties hereto. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties with respect to its subject matter, and supersedes all prior and contemporaneous agreements, understandings, and representations relating thereto. The invalidity or unenforceability of any particular provision of this Agreement shall not affect the other provisions, and this Agreement shall be construed in all respects as if any invalid or unenforceable provision were omitted.
